

Income Generation Project in Kirtipur-6, Devchuli Municipality; May-June 2018- Progress Report

Jagriti Child and Youth concern Nepal, with support from Nepalhilfe BH Germany, is conducting a community income generation Project in Devchuli Municipality, Ward Number 6, Kirtipur. After Distribution of goats to 20 families in April, the animal husbandry is going on smoothly and simultaneous community orientation programs are also going on.

Activities in June

1. Regular Goat and Shed Observation

The social mobilizer of Kirtipur for IGP, Ms. Anjila Soti has been carrying out regular goat and shed observation in the community and interacting with the beneficiary families as well. She has been consulting with the vet in case of any mild illness to a goat as well. All the goats are currently in a healthy condition.



2. WASH Programs



A Water, sanitation and hygiene program was also conducted in the school and the community. Ms. Anjila Soti has facilitated such programs and she also regularly promotes sanitation and hygiene in community having informal communication as well.

3. Conduction of Agricultural Group Meeting



An agricultural group meeting was also held in the community. This was facilitated by the social mobilizer. In the meeting, the families shared the status of their goats and if they had faced any difficulties in the animal husbandry.

4. Facilitation in Local Level Planning Process

JCYCN's district coordinator having regular formal/informal meetings with local level government to allocate budget with prioritizing the need of the Kirtipur community and local level government also positive to work on that community with allocating budget in upcoming their programs, mostly focusing the cash crops and livelihood programs

5. Observation and Feedback Received:

As the husbandry is going smoothly so far, if 20 other families can be benefitted from the same program, the municipality will also give recognition to the beneficiaries. This will ensure that the government shows ownership for the sustainability of the project and the community also be able to gain other government program benefits.

The primary and critical observation of the place is that the community lacks a proper health center. Due to the monsoon, the roads are constantly blocked as there are no well-constructed roads leading to the community. So, if there is any serious health issue to any community members in the raining season even they can't go the nearby town hospital so the next areas of intervention is supporting for basic health services in the community. And Local government is ready to support us providing the staff and running cost if there we can build the health post there.
