PRELIMINARY BASE-LINE SURVEY FOR THE HOUSEHOLD SELECTION

On April 6, Total 50 household including 25 houses from barhakol and 25 houses from belswara were surveyed for the household selection.

10 families from barhakol and 10 families from belswara, Altogether 20 needy families having low economic condition are selected for the goat distribution under Income Generation Program. Selected Families are happy and hopeful for their economic upliftment through this program.

Information about the condition of the families, their livelihood, income source and about the condition of their children was known.

On April 8, A program was conducted in Devchuli-16, Belswara, organized by Jcycn with the support of Kinder In Nepal, Nepalhilife Bleingheim Hersfeld e.v.

The primary objective of the program was to form a project advisory committee. The program was facilitated by the General Secretary of Jcycn, Deepak Sharma and was chaired by the ward chairperson of Devchuli ward no. 16, Keshav Raj Gautam.

Information about the condition of children and Adolescents of hilly area of devchuli-16 i.e. belswara was collected and required programs and plans were discussed for their enhancement & solution.

Farmers are hopeful for good income through goat rearing of advanced breed and also for the improvements in their economic status & children's education. They expressed their gratitude to the organization for the encouragement and support in goat rearing & direct concern in their children's topic.

On-site Inspection/ Field Visit of Barhakol

Field visit of Devchuli-16, Barhakol, was done with the purpose of survey/overview of the selected household and condition of goat's shed.

Through this field visit of barhakol, it was known that agriculture and animal husbandry are the main source of income. People had invested in animal husbandry but still not being able to generate income and raise their economic status. We got to know that, some family are starving for food and struggling for their livelihood.

Condition of goat's shed of the selected house was inspected and some sheds seems to be improved and maintained. Similarly, Condition of children was discussed from where, we got to know that many family are not able to afford education for their children and even if they can afford, children has to come down (far away from their family) to the market for their secondary level education.
