OBSERVATION & FIELD VISIT OF THE PROJECT UNDER INCOME GENERATION PROGRAM

01.05.2023

On May 1st, Selected Farmers of Devchuli-16, Barhakol and Belswara along with the members of Advisory committee for the Income Generation Program and local representatives, visited kritipur. The visit was facilitated by former staff of IG, Anjali Soti.

Meeting & interaction with the farmers of devchuli-6, kritipur who are rearing the goats and a discussion between the farmer groups of devchuli-6 and 16 was done. Farmers of Barhakol & Belswara visited & observed the condition of goats, goats' shed and got information about the achievements of IG program of kritipur as they are making good income & investing in their children's education as well as for their livelihood through goat rearing.





1 DAY ORIENTATION AND STUDY OBSERVATION WORKSHOP ON ANIMAL (GOAT) REARING.

01.05.2023

On May 1st, An orientation and study observation program was conducted in Devchuli-6, kritipur, organized by Jcycn with the support of Nepalhilife Bleingheim Hersfeld e.v. The primary objective of the program was to teach the proper way of goat rearing, goats' shed management, provide detail information about the symptoms of goats' diseases & also methods, measures to be adapted for it's treatment.

The program was facilitated by Mr. Narayan Poudel, and was chaired by the ward chairperson of Devchuli ward no. 6, Min Bahadur Soti and was successfully accomplished in the presence of ward chairperson of devhuli-10, Repti Kumar Gharti Magar.

Information about the condition of goats, goats' shed, income from goat rearing, condition of children and their education at kritipur, was collected and required training related to goat rearing, goats' shed construction & their management. Experience & achievements of goats rearing was shared by the farmers of kritipur.

Chair of the program expresses that the farmers of kritipur has been able to afford their children's education expenses, household expenses, health insurance of their children, and even monthly saving from goat rearing under IG program. He also expressed his commitments to work in coordination with the organization in upcoming days too.

Similarly, Ward chairperson of devchuli-10, Repti Kumar Gharti Magar highlighted the importance of the program to fulfill the gap as magar community is behind in education as compare to other communities. He also suggests to work in an organized manner, get as much as benefits from goat rearing and gave his best wishes for the success of the program.

Farmers expressed their happiness and gratitude to the organization for the encouragement and support for the improvements in their economic status & children's through goat rearing. They also expressed the need to distribute goats to more families and are hopeful for their economic upliftment through this goat rearing program.


