

Educational Materials for Schools

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Teaching has resumed at Balsiddha Basic School in Madhyabindu Municipality-15 after repairs were completed following the devastating floods in the Narayani River on 28 September. The school had suffered extensive damage due to the flood. The classrooms, furniture, and other materials were submerged in muddy water, making it impossible for the school to conduct classes for an extended period, according to school authorities.

Due to the challenges faced by young children and pre-primary level students in continuing their studies, the classrooms were reconstructed to create a child-friendly learning environment.

Especially for young children of Early Childhood Development class and pre-primary level, the learning environment had difficulty continuing their studies, therefore, the classrooms were reconstructed and made child-friendly. This initiative was carried out with the coordination of Madhyabindu Municipality and the support of Jagriti Child and Youth Concern Nepal, and Nepalhilfe BH eV. Germany to restore the flood-damaged school classrooms into child-friendly.

Three classrooms were repainted, the walls decorated, and the ECD (Early Childhood Development) room was managed at approximately NPR 1 million, shared Deepak Sharma, General Secretary of Jagriti Child and Youth Concern Nepal. Mr. Sharma added that along with the reconstruction of the school, educational materials were distributed at Balsiddha Basic School as part of the campaign "Joyful Journey of Children to School". A total of 72 students enrolled at the school received educational materials. These included school bags, notebooks, pens, jackets, toothpaste, and other essential items.

The Mayor of Madhyabindu Municipality, Bhim Lal Adhikari, stated that the municipality introduced the concept of the "Happiness Curriculum" with the goal of enhancing the educational development of children. He mentioned that, in line with this vision, they had been actively working towards it. The floods on 27 and 28 September caused significant damage in various areas of the municipality, including schools, prompting support from Jagriti Child and Youth Concern Nepal. He emphasized the importance of prioritizing education, noting that, along with food, shelter, and clothing, health and education are also basic needs.

Deepak Bashyal, the coordinator of Nepalhilfe BH eV. Germany shared that for the past 15 years, they have been distributing educational materials and warm clothing in schools as part of the "Joyful Journey of Children to School" campaign, aiming to make students happy in school and positively impact them, while also discussing with parents how to make their livelihoods easier.

विशेष गरेर बालकक्षा, पूर्वप्राथमिक तहका बालबालिकालाई अध्ययन गर्न असहज भएपछि अहिले पुनर्निर्माण गरेर बालमैत्री कक्षा व्यवस्थापन गरिएको हो। मध्यविन्दु नगरपालिकाको समन्वयमा जागृति बाल तथा युवा सरोकार नेपाल, नेपाल हिल्फे विटिकम किन्डर इन चिल्ड्रेन नेपालको सहयोगमा बाढीबाट क्षति पुगेको विद्यालयको कक्षाकोठा बालमैत्री बनाइएको हो।
