HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MEETING

- It was decided that 10 families from Barhakol and 10 from Belswara will be selected by the advisory committee along with the verification from the official team.



FIELD VISIT

On 29-30 November 2024, a field visit was conducted under Income Generation Program in devchuli municipality ward no.16, Barhakol & Belswara. The visit aimed to observe the condition of goats and their sheds, ensure proper management practices, and inform families and the advisory committee about the program's third phase.

- 2.Earning of Rs.15,000 was done by Mr. Kul Bahadur Pata by selling given mature male goat.
- 3.Improved livestock management, enhanced ownership of the program among advisory committee and farmers and positive progress indicates the favorable environment for the expansion of the project.
- 4.Additional educational support, regular school visits, and meetings with teachers and families have contributed to creating a supportive and better environment for children.


